

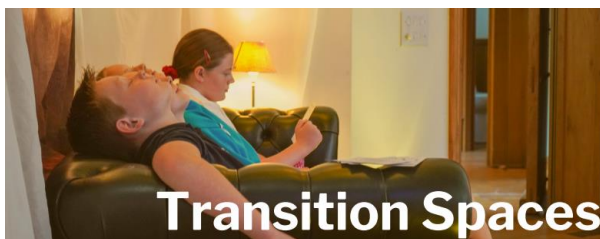

This is a safe space for free movement through 15 prayer stations, followed by reflection, a workshop and the building of a shared posture prayer. The session ends with a focus on each pupil's unique role in the communities they are part of, and will be in the future.

Bolton Abbey Trip



On **Tuesday 15th July** the whole school will be going to Bolton Abbey. All children will need to arrive at school promptly as the coach will be setting off at 9.15am and returning by 3.30pm. A school packed lunch will be provided for all children if requested and can children bringing a home packed lunch bring it in a disposable bag. Please give consent and pay £10 per child on Parentpay towards the cost of the trip and FOBBS have kindly agreed to pay the remaining balance. Children will be required to wear a school t-shirt and sweatshirt/cardigan with casual

trousers e.g. tracksuit bottoms/shorts/leggings and comfy trainers or boots. Depending on the weather, a sun hat or rain coat must be worn and please can sun protection be applied before arriving at school. If children would like to buy an ice-cream or ice lolly please can they bring a maximum of £5 to spend and give it to their teacher for safe keeping.
